

**Ruhr-Universität Bochum (RUB) - Doctoral Researcher (f/m/d) at the Chair of Environmental/Resource Economics and Sustainability (Prof. Löschel)**

Ruhr-Universität Bochum (RUB) is one of Germany's leading research universities, addressing the whole range of academic disciplines. To create knowledge networks within and beyond the university is RUB's declared aim.

The Chair of Environmental/Resource Economics and Sustainability (Prof. Löschel) at the Faculty of Economics of the Ruhr-University Bochum has a vacancy for a full time research assistant (m/f/d) starting as soon as possible and limited until August 31, 2024. The regular working hours are currently 39 hours and 50 minutes per week with full employment. As a matter of principle, positions will also be filled on a part-time basis, unless there are compelling service-related reasons to the contrary in individual cases.

The willingness to pursue a doctoral degree and participation in doctoral courses are required; support for doctoral studies is provided. The focus of the work and research activity is within the framework of a project. For this purpose, a market model for hydrogen is to be developed. The model shall enable the evaluation of different incentive systems with regard to the successful market introduction of hydrogen in the German economy.

**Requirements:** An above-average degree in economics, business mathematics or a comparable qualification. In-depth knowledge of microeconomics and the willingness to familiarize oneself with modern methods, especially of empirical economic research, are expected.

**We offer:** Participation in a dynamic, cooperative team, active involvement in the research activities of the chair, opportunities to implement research in externally funded projects.
